- All contestants must be a SC resident or currently enrolled in a SC School
  - *There are NO RESTRICTIONS on winners who wish to compete in other pageants.*
  - All decisions made by the pageant director & judges are final.
  - Any unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification from the pageant with no refund.
  - Your age on March 10<sup>th</sup> determines the group you compete in.
  - You may move up 1 age group, but you may not move down.

## Pageant Entry Fee : Beauty/Charming, Theme Wear & Photogenic Competition **All 3 categories for \$75.00**

- People's Choice Competition **NO FEE TO ENTER**
  - Sweetheart Competition fee is based on **SIGNATURES COLLECTED**
  - **Each contestant will be allowed to bring 1 chaperone free of charge.**
  - Admission to the pageant is \$5.00 per person. Children ages 6 & under are free.

## Beauty Competition

- The Beauty/Charming competition will be judged first in the pageant, then Theme wear.
  - Girl's 0-9 yrs compete in a short pageant dress, Girl's/Ladies 10 & up compete in long pageant dress.
  - Boys 1-6 yrs compete in pants outfit, slacks/shirt, suit, tux. **NO JEANS PLEASE.**
  - All dresses/gowns should be age appropriate and in good taste.
  - At the end of each age group contestants will come back out for a collective line up together.
  - The contestant with the highest score will be the Beauty/Charming Winner in that age group.

### **St Pat's Theme Wear Competition**

- Theme Wear competition will be judged second in the pageant following Beauty/Charming competition.
  - Theme wear is described as: An outfit of your choice that you feel brings the St Pat's in 5 Points spirit to the stage! Be creative!!
  - Props that can be managed by the contestant ONLY are allowed. No glitter, confetti or live animals allowed.
  - There will NOT be a collective line up in Theme wear. As soon as you have competed, please change back into your pants outfit/dress/gown for crowning.
  - The contestant with the highest Theme wear score will be the Theme wear Winner in that age group.
  - The music and pace for Theme Wear will be upbeat and FUN!!

### **Photogenic Competition(Optional, but included in entry fee):**

- You may enter a professional and/or an amateur picture(s) in color or in black & white.
  - Any size up to 8 x 10 is allowed.
  - Each contestant may enter up to 3 photos.
  - Please mark ALL PHOTOS with the contestant's first and last name.
  - Pictures MUST be mailed in with application. Please do not mail in any type of FRAME.
  - All pictures will be returned to you when you check in for the pageant.
  - The picture with the highest score in each age group will be the photogenic winner.

### **Crowning**

- We prefer that contestants wear their Pants outfit/Dresses/Evening Gowns for crowning.
  - We will not double crown the Beauty Winners & The Overall Winners.
  - ALL CONTESTANTS need to stay in the area after crowning so they can hear the OVERALL WINNER announced for the morning pageant and the afternoon pageant.
  - All winners and runner's up need to stay after the pageant to have their group photos taken
  - There is a possibility that the Sweetheart Winners & the People's Choice winners might also be a Beauty Winner and/or an Overall Winner.

### **Beauty, Theme wear & Photogenic:**

- Each group will have a 2<sup>nd</sup> runner up , a 1<sup>st</sup> runner up and a Beauty/Charming Winner.
  - Beauty/Charming Winner will get a trophy, banner, crown.
  - Theme wear winner & and Photogenic winner will receive a gift.
  - Runners up will get a trophy
  - ALL contestants will receive a participation gift.

### **Overall Winners**

- The morning pageant & the afternoon pageant will each have an OVERALL WINNER.
  - This is awarded to the contestant that has the highest combined score in all 3 categories.
  - Only 1 girl will win from the morning pageant & Only 1 girl/lady will win from the afternoon pageant.
  - 1 BOY will win an overall title from the 3 boys divisions and will receive the same awards
  - WE WILL NOT DOUBLE CROWN. This means if a contestant that wins the OVERALL title he/she will NOT be crowned the Beauty winner in her own age group. Overall Winners will receive a large trophy, banner, crown and \$100.00 dollars cash!!
